

This Cookie Policy regarding the processing of data through cookies and other tracking technologies is provided in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data (hereinafter, the “Regulation” or “GDPR”), Legislative Decree No. 196/2003 (and subsequent amendments), the decision of the Italian Data Protection Authority (Garante per la protezione dei dati personali) “*Identification of simplified procedures for the information notice and the acquisition of consent for the use of cookies*” dated 8 May 2014, as well as the subsequent “*Clarifications regarding the implementation of the legislation on cookies*” dated 5 June 2015 and the “*Guidelines on cookies and other tracking tools*” dated 10 June 2021, and, more generally, the applicable national and European Legislation.

Where personal data relating to users are collected through cookies, we will process such data in accordance with our Privacy Policy, to which you are invited to refer for any further information regarding the processing of personal data carried out by us through the Website.

You may amend your consent to cookies and/or your preferences regarding the use of cookies at any time by following the instructions set out in Section 3 of this Policy.

1. Data Controller

The Data Controller is OQEMA S.p.A., with registered office in Assago, Via Roggia Bartolomea no. 7 – 20057, VAT No. 00080290182 (hereinafter also referred to as “OQEMA” or the “Company”).

2. What cookies are

Cookies are packets of information sent by a web server (e.g., the Website) to the user’s Internet browser, automatically stored by the latter on the user’s computer and automatically sent back to the server upon each subsequent access to the Website.

Through the use of cookies, we are able to facilitate the user’s browsing of the Website, as well as to analyse the user’s preferences and tastes and, consequently, to offer products and services that are more consistent with the user’s interests and expectations.

Cookies differ depending on their purpose: while some cookies are strictly necessary for browsing the Website (such as those required to enable navigation or to provide a service requested by the user), others serve different purposes and therefore require the user’s consent in order to be installed (such as, for example, those used to create user profiles and display personalised advertising).

In addition, cookies may typically be installed:

- directly by the owner and/or operator of the website (so-called “first-party cookies”);
- by entities that are not part of the website visited by the user (so-called “third-party cookies”). Unless otherwise specified, please note that such cookies fall under the direct and exclusive responsibility of the relevant operator. Further information on privacy and their use is available directly on the websites of the respective operators.

3. Types of Cookies

Cookies and other tracking tools can be classified:

3.1 Based on duration

3.1.1 Session cookies

These cookies are not stored persistently on the user’s computer and are deleted when the browser is closed. They are strictly limited to the transmission of session identifiers necessary to enable secure and efficient browsing of the Website, thereby avoiding the use of other IT techniques that may potentially prejudice the confidentiality of users’ browsing.

3.1.2 Persistent cookies

These cookies remain stored on the computer’s hard drive until they expire or are deleted by users/visitors. Through persistent cookies, visitors who access the Website (or any other users who use the same computer) are automatically recognised at each visit. Visitors may configure their computer browser so as to accept/reject all cookies or to display a warning each time a cookie is proposed, in order to decide whether to

accept it or not. In any event, the user may change the default settings and disable cookies (i.e., block them permanently) by setting the highest level of protection.

This Website does not use persistent cookies. However, by browsing the pages of this Website, as mentioned above, you may interact with websites operated by third parties that may create or modify persistent and profiling cookies.

3.2 Based on the purpose for which they are installed:

3.2.1 Technical cookies

These cookies are essential for the operation of our website and for the provision of our services and therefore cannot be disabled. They are generally stored only as a result of your actions, for example if you submit a request regarding a product. You can set your browser so that these cookies are blocked; however, doing so will limit the functionality of the website. Necessary cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.

3.2.2 Analytics cookies

These cookies allow us to analyse the use of our website, for example through the number of visitors and data traffic, in order to collect information aimed at improving performance. The information collected by these cookies is aggregated and therefore anonymous. If you do not allow these cookies, we will not be able to make improvements and provide you with a tailored experience.

3.2.3 Profiling and marketing cookies

These cookies allow us to create profiles of your interests in order to display relevant content on other websites. They are stored by us or by our advertising partners. In order to provide you with relevant content, we use your interactions together with the personal information you have provided on our website. For tailored content on third-party websites, we provide this information and a customer identifier—such as an email address or an encrypted device ID—to third parties, for example advertising platforms and social networks.

4. Cookie Preference Management

4.1 Cookie Banner and Preference Centre

Upon accessing any page of the Website, a banner is displayed containing a brief notice regarding the cookies used by the Data Controller. Through this banner, the user may:

- accept all cookies;
- reject all cookies;
- make no selection by clicking the “X” in the upper-right corner of the banner; in this case, the default settings will remain in place (which provide for the installation of technical cookies only, as necessary for the operation of the Website);
- choose, on a granular basis, which cookies to install

Please note that your consent will be requested only upon your first access to the Website, as it will be stored for up to 6 months in order to allow you to access the Website pages directly upon your return. You may also manage your cookie preferences at any time through the “Cookie Settings” section of the Website.

4.2 Browser settings

Most browsers allow you to accept, manage and disable Cookies through your settings. Through the browser it will also be possible to disable the Technical Cookies: however, this may cause malfunctions of the Site or affect the correct use of the Site.
